6. Make your child visit important places like Bank, Zoo, Vegetable Market, Post Office, Botanical garden etc.

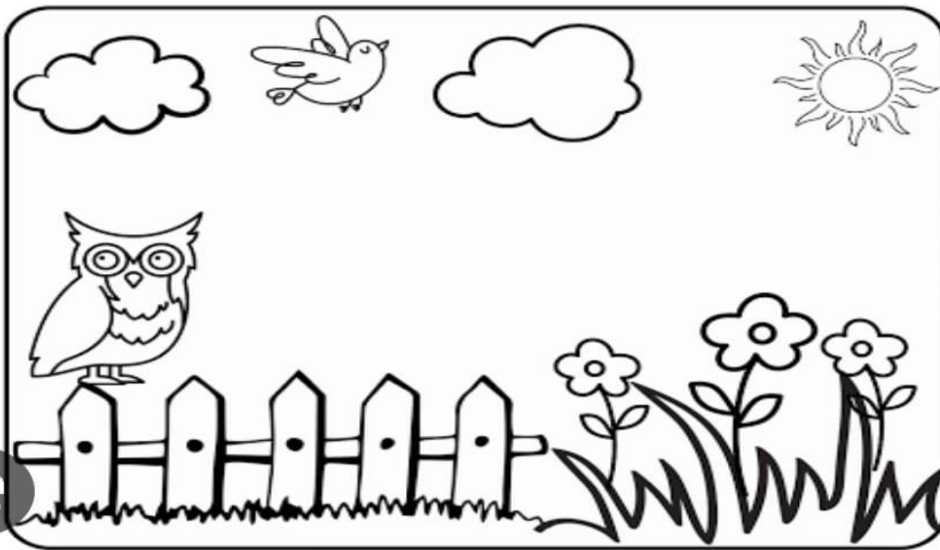
