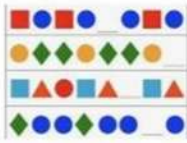
We request you to guide your child and help them use their time in a positive and meaningful way. This will encourage curiosity, enhance learning, and make the process enjoyable. Thank you for your support.

Here are some fun and creative activities to keep our little ones happily engaged.

• **Patterns:**



Practice different patterns like standing lines, sleeping lines, slanting lines, and curves. Children can use crayons on worksheets and also try making patterns in salt or flour.

• **Counting:** Practice oral counting from 1 to 10. Make it fun by counting objects like spoons, plates, toys, or by doing activities like bead stringing.

• **Same & Different:** Revise the concept using objects at home. Encourage your child to identify and explain what is same and what is different.

• **Colours (Red, Blue, Yellow):** Talk about colours in the surroundings and help your child identify objects of these colours.

PAPER PLATE CLOWN ACTIVITY



Learning Objective:

Develops creativity, fine motor skills, and color recognition.

Materials Required:

Paper plates, colored paper strips, glue, scissors, sketch pen, tissue paper.

Method:

Decorate the paper plate by drawing a clown face. Paste colorful paper circles around the plate and attach paper strips at the bottom for hair. Add a bow using tissue paper.

LION FACE CRAFT ACTIVITY



Learning Objective:

Develops creativity, fine motor skills, and color recognition.
Enhances imagination and hand-eye coordination.

Materials Required:

Colored paper, ribbon strips, ice cream stick, glue, scissors, sketch pen, googly eyes (optional).

Method:

Cut a circle from colored paper to make the lion's face. Paste ribbon strips around the circle as the mane. Draw the face or stick googly eyes. Attach an ice cream stick at the back to hold the craft.

SENSORY BALLOON ACTIVITY



Learning Objective:

This activity helps in developing sensory exploration, fine motor skills and emotional regulation.

Materials Required:

Balloons 2, flour/rice/sand, funnel or spoon, markers (for drawing faces), thread or rubber bands.

Method:

Fill two balloons with different materials like flour, rice, or sand using a funnel. Tie the balloon tightly to secure the filling. Children can press, squeeze, roll, and explore the texture of the sensory balloons. You can also

draw fun faces on the balloons.

STRAW MAZE ACTIVITY



Learning Objective:

Enhances problem-solving skills, concentration, and hand-eye coordination.

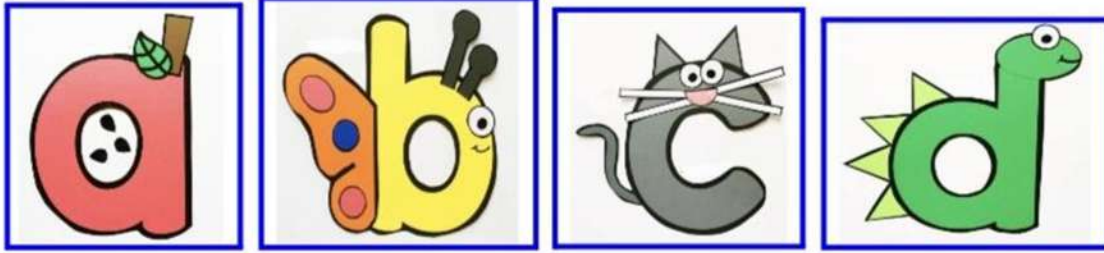
Materials Required:

Cardboard box or paper plate, colorful straws, small beads/balls, glue.

Method:

Cut and stick straws inside the box or plate to create a maze. Place a small ball or bead and let children move it through the maze by tilting the box.

LETTER CRAFT ACTIVITY



Learning Objective:

Helps children recognize the letters a ,b ,c,d, their sound, and improves creativity and fine motor skills.

Materials Required:

Colored paper, glue, scissors, sketch pen, googly eye (optional).

Method:

Cut the shape of letter and decorate it to look like the given pictures by adding spikes, eye, and mouth. Let children color and decorate.

CATERPILLAR CRAFT ACTIVITY



Learning Objective:

Develops creativity, fine motor skills, and color recognition. Enhances hand-eye coordination and imagination.

Materials Required:

Colored paper, pom-poms, googly eyes, glue, scissors, sketch pen.

Method:

Cut leaf shapes from colored paper. Paste colorful pom-poms on the leaf to make a caterpillar body and add googly eyes to complete the craft.
