2	9 to 16	<b>Time Diary:</b> Create a "Sunday Schedule." Record the exact time you wake up, eat lunch, and go to bed. Draw the clock hands for each of these times in your notebook.
3	17 to 24	<b>Bill Explorer:</b> Take an old grocery bill. Find the three most expensive items and the three cheapest. Calculate the total difference between the most and least expensive items.
4	25 to 32	<b>Odd and Even Pot:</b> Draw two large pots on a A4 size sheet—one for "Odd" and one for "Even." Have your child find numbers up to 200 (from old newspapers or by asking family) and paste them as "flowers" in the correct pot.
5	33 & Above	<b>Place Value Accordion:</b> Create a folding paper "accordion" where numbers are written in expanded form. When folded, only the full number shows; when pulled open, it reveals the place values (e.g., $400 + 70 + 8$ ).
